Texas Ranger Chipotle Porter.....27

750ml

6.6% ABV, Just like everything Mikkeller brews, this porter offers a symphony for the senses. Aromas of cocoa dusted smoked peppers with malt and coffee entice toward an equally impressive palate. Like the appearance the mouth feel is full and rich with flavors of chocolate sauce and toasted malt. Finally the chili comes to play; the acid brightens up the mid palate and the heat leaves a spicy tinge begging you to take another sip. Cheers!

Pannepot.....14

330ml

10% ABV, The name comes from the fishing boats that lined the French coast of De Panne in the early 1900s, and brewed in honor of the fishermen and the ale they drank. "Pannepot is an unfiltered, unpasteurized, bottle-conditioned dark ale with an intense, complex chocolate malt aroma, roasted accents, and subtle hints of spice."

Malheur Brut Reserve.....47

750ml

11% ABV, Although; some may disagree, this is the true Champagne of beer. This strong golden ale attains its gushing carbonation through the very same method that is used in the making of Champagne. Fruity esters, a bold yet velvety mouth feel, and long warm finish make this one of a kind Biere Brut a libation to be treasured.

Oak Aged La Trappe Quadruple.....33

375ml

10% ABV, Every ones favorite quadruple ale is transformed by aging in various oak port barrels for a minimum of one year. The result is a beer of incredible cognac like complexity, delicate spice, warm sultry mouth feel, and modest carbonation, resulting in a fluffy, off white head.

Oud Beersel Kriek.....36

750ml

6.5% ABV, Made naturally with water, malted barley, wheat, and an astonishing 400 grams of cherries per liter of hops. Amaretto champagne with crisp bing cherry, Worlds best kriek 2009. Natural spontaneous fermentation creates a tart, mouthwatering acidity that is reminiscent of a fine wine.

Achel Trappist Extra.....34

750ml

9.5% ABV, Trappist ale, pours a deep ruby red, warm phenols prepare you for the full bodied, full flavored ale in front of you. Active carbonation balances the sweet undertone, that carries flavors of figs and dried fruit. The finish is creamy with notes of toffee and clove

Glazen Toren Saison d'erpe Mere.....34

750ml

6.9% ABV, hazy straw yellow, superb lacing, lemongrass with a tinge of straw, ripe apricot flesh, creamy long lasting finish with notes of black pepper. "Modern Belgium brewers utilizing unorthodox flavors."

Wandering Aengus.....21

500ml

6.8% ABV, Zero percent Residual Sugars Cold ferment 2 months, aged 6 months On medium toast French oak last month. Rich tannins and spicy aromas with a mild oak finish. Blend of English and French bittersweet apples rounded out with aromatic and sharp heirloom apples. NATURALLY GLUTEN FREE

Anchorage White Out.....30

750ml

6.5% ABV Belgian style wheat beer brewed with Brettanomyces and aged in French Chardonnay barrels. Enticing vinous aroma, fresh baked and buttered sourdough, light citrusy palate, dry lemon meringue finish

Drie Fonteinen Oude Gueze.....25

375ml

6% ABV, Gueze is made as a blend of young and old Lambics. Young Lambic has been aging in oak for 1 year, while old has matured over 3 years. The unfermented sugars in the young Lambic allow for fermentation in the bottle when combined with the old Lambic containing higher concentrations of yeast.

Struisse Outblack.....14

330ml

10% ABV, De Struisse collaborated with the gypsy brewer Stillwater in order to create this Belgian Strong Ale; blended with Black IPA. Appearance is oily black with a light tan head. A bouquet of flavors shine through before you even take your first sip: dark chocolate, stewed dark fruit, fresh bing cherries, all balanced by a subtle evergreen hoppy aroma. The taste actually lives up to the complex full flavored aroma; no wonder De Struisse is considered to be one of the Worlds top breweries.

Moonlight Meadery "Flirt".....33

375ml

13.9% ABV, Mead, or honey wine, is the ancestor of all fermented beverages. It is a lost art being reincarnated at Moonlight Meadery in New Hampshire. This ancient libation has quenched the palates of philosophers, nobles and peasants alike for 8000 years. Moonlight's "Flirt" is brewed with apricots, lending the fruits natural acidity to balance the sweet honey overtones. Slightly spicy, succulent, juicy and tart

Reserve Bottles

Nogne-O Batch 500.....20 500ml

10% ABV, "When Nøgne Ø decided to make it's 500th batch of beer, it was quickly established that the key numbers would be 5 malts, 5 hops, 10% alcohol and 100 IBUs. The result is an incredibly rich and hoppy Imperial IPA. Malty enough to be almost a barley wine, but intensely fruity, mainly because it is dry hopped with generous amounts of Nelson Sauvin hops from New Zealand."

Nogne-O Imperial Stout.....18 500ml

9% ABV, motor oil black, roasted malt, creamy mocha, scent of anise, almost too drinkable, "The way the tsar would have preferred his stout", Gold medalist at The Australian International Beer Awards 2010, and bronze in 2011.

Nogne-O Dark Horizon.....27 250ml

15.5% ABV, Third edition of the dark horizon series, brewed with coffee and "best described as an imperial stout on steroids." So good we almost kept it for ourselves! We strongly recommend letting it evolve in your glass as it slowly warms to room temperature, assuming it lasts that long. The bottle is presented in a beautiful can that you can take to remind you of your delicious encounter.

Nogne-O Sweet Horizon.....27 250ml

14% ABV, "sweet Horizon is dessert for the ones with a sweet tooth. Black and velvety, with hints of sweet chocolate, fruit, coffee, licorice.....mmmmm! But remember, this is dessert, so do not try to have dessert with it!"

Fantome Dark White.....30 750ml

4% ABV, This unique take on saison will send your sense of taste on a journey. "Uncorks like champagne! Few beers have had such pop n' steam." Pours a dark copper with light sediment. A lively head explodes with aroma of: csic saison barnyard funk, lemon pepper, young green apples dipped in hot caramel. Rich full body of fruit, malt and grain is washed away by crisp gushing carbonation that leaves a remarkable dry finish.

Jolly Pumpkin La Parcela.....30 750ml

6% ABV, tart ale brewed with lots of pumpkins, a touch of warm spice and hints of cacao to "lighten the soul" This one wont last, so don't miss out

Mikkeller Black Hole.....27 Choice of: *Tequila, Red Wine, Cognac* or *Scotch* Barrel Aged Version

375ml

13.1 % ABV, Brewed with coffee vanilla and honey and then aged in respective barrels: "Finally...! Black Hole is what Mikkeller is all about. Daring, vulgar and extreme. From the very beginning Mikkellers goal has been to push the limit and with this warming, intense imperial stout, a new chapter in the Danish beer history has been written. The high bitterness from the hops and the sweetness from the malt and alcohol, creates a good balance which makes Black Hole an explosion of nuances, but also leaves a feeling of a perfect and complex beer - in the heavyweight category." -- Mikkeller

Single Hop Series by Mikkeller:

6.8% ABV, Each beer in this series was brewed with the same batch of malt, and the same strain of yeast in order to showcase each individual hop.

Higher alpha acids (AA) usually indicate a higher level of hop bitterness.

Mt. Hood 4-6% AA

An aromatic variety that is a cross with Hallerau, it is also related to Ultra, Liberty and Crystal varieties. Slightly spicier than its relatives, it also has relatively low alpha acids making it a great variety for finishing lagers and wheat beers.

Magnum 12-14% AA

All purpose bittering hop. Known for its clean floral and citrus character. Bred in Germany in 1980 at a hop research facility called Huell. Cross between Galena and another German hop.

Simcoe 12-14% AA

A unique American hybrid bred by Yakima Chief Ranches first released in 2000, and used primarily as a bittering hop. It is less astringent than other pine-like hops and has been highly sought after to make distinctive and unique Pale Ales. Believed superior due to low cohumulone levels.

Warrior 15-17% AA

A bittering hop that is quickly becoming popular as a result of its use in many American style IPA's. This variety has a low aroma level that mainly consists of citrus and pine.

Mikkeller Nelson Sauvin Brut.....45 750ml

9% ABV, Brewed with Brettanomyces and New Zealand's native hop: Nelson Sauvin, which is named after its likeness to sauvignon blanc. After fermentation, the beer is aged in Austrian sauvignon blanc casks for five months to further its complexity
